OVERVIEW & SUPPORTED FEATURES

This is a two-way driver to control browsing, navigation and playback functions of the Volumio system with metadata feedback.

Elan is capable of querying the server, returning cover art and metadata and then directing content to the zone player and querying the player every 5 seconds.

THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS ARE SUPPORTED BY [THIS DRIVER]:

- Volumio Build 2.673 or Higher.
- Volumio Plugins: Tidal, Qobuz, Spotify (limited), Web Radio

THE FOLLOWING PLAYBACK OPTIONS are **not supported by [this driver]:**

Some Volumio plugins developed by third party developers are not supported and may crash the driver.



CONFIGURATION


Setup and install [Volumio](#) according to the [manufacturer's instructions](#). Ensure proper operation first using a web browser or the Volumio Companion app for Android or iOS.

Installation Process


1. Download the driver and unzip in the folder where all the EDRVC files are located.
2. Open Media, Source, Add New Generic Media Source
3. Navigate to the folder where the driver is located and Choose the Volumio




4. Click OK on the warning that this is not a Native Elan driver,
5. The Driver will automatically go into trial mode for 7 days. Wait for about 10 seconds and the Status will turn Green. Fill in the IP address and the activation key and click Apply.



6. Under the Settings, Turn on / off services as desired.
IMPORTANT NOTE: We recommend turning off Navigation Cover Art. This will make the driver faster. The driver will still display the cover art of what's currently playing.



7. Add the Source to the Zone Controller. Add the logo included in the downloaded folder



Using the Driver

The Driver uses the standard Elan Media control to give the user a familiar interface.

1. The Main Interface is to navigate the library, clear play queue, show play queue, transport button, display meta data information and cover art of the currently playing media.



2. To start playback, navigate to the desired library item and choose > to start playback or + to add it the current queue. Queued items are added to the end of the list. Choose → to go the submenu.



3. Some menu items have sublevels. Continue navigation till an item is playable. Headings are not playable.



e.g. Browsing by Artist, shows Albums and Tracks. Items with (Artist) in the name are headings and are not clickable
